

# COVID-19 DECISION TREE

Someone you know has tested positive—  
determine your need to quarantine.

Were you a **CLOSE CONTACT** of someone who tested positive for COVID-19?  
The CDC defines a close contact as any individual who has spent at **least 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period, within 6 feet of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.**

**NO**

You are not required to Quarantine.

**YES**

Are you fully vaccinated, boosted, or have you tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 90 days?

**NO**

Stay home and quarantine for 5 days. Do not travel to work or to class.

Even if you do not develop symptoms, get tested at least 5 days following close contact.\*

If 5 days have passed, and you have a negative COVID-19 test, you can return to work or class.

**YES**

Wear a face mask at all times for 10 days while on campus.

Monitor for COVID-19 symptoms. Unless you develop symptoms, you are not required to quarantine.

Even if you don't develop symptoms, get tested at least 5 days following close contact.\*

*\*If you test positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, immediately begin [isolation procedures](#).*

**Students** are responsible for consulting with their faculty member(s) regarding options to complete assigned course work while completing their required quarantine/isolation period.

**Employees** are responsible for notifying their supervisor of a positive test result, or confirmation of close contact with someone with COVID-19.
